If you email it - the parent is on their own but when I send the link- I will make sure that the read the information about how to answer the questions. The other option is to just share your screen so you are right there with them.

My team is typically split on whether supports are billable or not and whether they need a POC or not. In other settings, some of these things would be totally billable.

I usually document on forms when I do teaching on equipment and am delegating to staff.

The forms from Durham are great and I do not bill for any SAS

We don't bill ours but do a simple POC just in case.

I started doing the POC's for SAS since ECATs added the check box for it HA!

We did do POC's for consultative kids in Florida just FYI
